FAQs

Is this a full time regular paid job?

No, this is not a full time regular job, this is a project specified for a fixed number of days

Is this a paid assignment?

Yes, honorarium will be paid as per the British Council policy and the amount will be shared with selected candidates. This is not a consultancy so honorarium is non-negotiable.

Is there any travel involved?

Yes, individuals are expected to travel in different cities across Pakistan when needed.

Who will be managing the travel and accommodation?

Traveling and accommodation costs will be covered by the British Council as per the policy.

What is the duration of the assignment?

Duration of the assignment covers August 2015 to July 2016

- 5 days of for attending training of facilitators (ToF)
- 20 days (4 workshops) spread over August till October 2015 with faculty
- 7 days spread over 10 months for field visits
- Allocation of dates will be mutually agreed as per timeline.

How to manage my existing engagements/commitments?

As mentioned earlier that this is not a full time job so you can continue it with your existing engagement/commitments. You will have to agree dates with the British Council which will help you out to manage your overall work. The British Council will not compensate for leave/time off in case of full time employees.

Is there any contract to be signed between the British Council and facilitator?

A legal contract covering all deliverables will be signed by the British Council and facilitator before joining the programme

What other benefits will I get?

- Certificate of training of facilitators (ToF)
- Reference letter after one year completion of committed activities

- Training by UK and Pak senior trainers
