










### What is your most important reason for voting?<sup>1</sup>













#### Name up to three problems that lead to conflict more generally in Pakistan<sup>7</sup>















## In your opinion, what are the three main motivations for young people to commit acts of violence in Pakistan?<sup>14</sup>






